ORDER


WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Sri Chennakeshava Educational Sociey, Cumbum, Prakasam District, Andhra Pradesh** has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to **Brilliant D.Ed College, Prakasam District** for conducting **D.Ed** course with an annual intake of 50 students on 31.10.2008.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, institution fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the Higher Teacher Education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.
3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Brilliant D.Ed College, Plot No.46/A, Door No. 8-76B, Kandulapuram, Cumbum, Prakasam District-523333, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting **D.Ed** Course of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 from the academic session **2011-12** under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009 subject of fulfillment of the following conditions:
 - i. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs.3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or Mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
 - ii. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - iii. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
 - iv. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
 - (i) Copy of the Application Form
 - (ii) Land and Building Particulars
 - (iii) Staff Profile
 - (iv) Recognition letter
 - (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, Sri Chennakesava Educational Society, Plot No.25-58-5, Near Urban Colony, Kandulapuram Village, Cumbum Post, Taluk & City, Prakasam District-523333, Andhra Pradesh had submitted an on-line application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE on 28.06.2015 and submitted print outs on 06.07.2015 for grant of recognition for D.El.Ed-AI programme of two units of 50 students Brilliant D.Ed College, Plot/ Khasara No.46/A, Plot No. 25-58-5, Nru colony Street, Kandulapuram Village, Cumbum Post, Taluk & City, Prakasam District-523333, Andhra Pradesh.

AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit submitted and the report received from VT and Videography, and the certificates received from the university, the Committee is satisfied that the applicant fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE ACT, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, financial resources, etc., for running the programme.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE ACT, 1993, the Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to Brilliant D.Ed College, Plot/ Khasara No.46/A, Plot No. 25-58-5, Nru colony Street, Kandulapuram Village, Cumbum Post, Taluk & City, Prakasam District-523333, Andhra Pradesh for conducting D.El.Ed-AI programme of two years duration with an additional intake of 100 students (two units only) from the academic sessions 2016-2017 under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained Perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDR's shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in Position.
- 2 Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / Body. the State Government etc, as applicable
 - 3 The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self- Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a chartered Accountant.
 - 4 The institutions shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter -alia, the details of the institution, its location, name of the programme applied for with intake; availability of physical infrastructure, such as Ind, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities or amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their proposed teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-
 - a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.

- c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
 - d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e) Fee charged from students;
 - f) Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
- 5 The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
- 6 The institution shall make available list of students admitted on its official website.

If the institution Contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the regional committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
